The team:

The composition of the participants and the numerical composition of the team:

- Teams of international Kyokushin federations (athletes who are allowed without restrictions in each weight category) are allowed to participate in the International Kyokushin Competition "Kazan Bars".
- All-Russian federations included in the ACR, no more than 2 people in each weight category.
- The Kyokushin Federation of Russia (IFK), as the organizer of the competition, has the right to field 4 people in each weight category.

The composition of the participants and the numerical composition of the team:

- the official representative of the team, the coach of the team;
- participants of the competition.
- the official team doctor.

Referees:

The official list of judges will be approved from among the accredited judges and published in the official competition group.

Candidates for judging who wish to attend the seminar on November 30, 2024 must submit an application by November 1, 2024 by e-mail: sensei578@mail.ru with an indication in the subject of the letter. (Appendix 3).

- The judges' uniform is a dark blue jacket, gray trousers, a white short–sleeve shirt, black shoes, and a whistle.

The chief judge of the competition is Alexey Gorokhov, 6th dan, Russia. The Chief Secretary is Anastasia Khimichenko, 1st dan, Russia.

Requirements for the participants of the competition:

Representatives of national federations and all interested Kyokushin groups in a given country, aged 10 and over, are allowed to participate in the competition.

Participants of the competition:

- among boys and girls aged 10-11, there may be athletes who turned 10 years old on the day of the competition, but were under 12 years old, who have qualifications in the sport of Kyokushin at least 9 kyu.
- among boys and girls aged 12-13, there may be athletes who turned 12 years old on the day of the competition, but were under 14 years old, who have qualifications in the sport of Kyokushin at least 8 kyu.
- among boys and girls of 14-15 years old, there may be athletes who turned 14 on the day of the competition, but did not turn 16, who have qualifications in the sport of Kyokushin at least 7 kyu.
- among juniors and juniors aged 16-17, there may be athletes who turned 16 on the day of the competition, but did not turn 18, who have qualifications in the sport of Kyokushin at least 6 kyu.
- among men and women, there may be athletes who turned 18 on the day of the competition, who are qualified in the sport of Kyokushin (Kyokushin discipline) at least 4 kyu.

Requirements for the participants of the competition:

At the mandate commission, the team leader provides the original application, and each participant must have the following documents:

- passport;
- Russian Russian or English) sports doctor's admission to participate in competitions, issued no earlier than November 6, 2024;
- HIV antibodies test certificate (in English or Russian), made no earlier than

November 6, 2024 (for foreign citizens).

- HBV antibodies test certificate (in English or Russian), made no earlier than November 6, 2024; (for foreign citizens).
- HCV antibodies test certificate (in English or Russian), made no earlier than November 6, 2024; (for foreign citizens).
- Budo passport of the organization confirming the style qualification.
- accident insurance contract valid at the time of the competition (original, in English or Russian);
- application from parents (age categories 12-13, 14-15, 16-17 years, the form is given in Appendix 1)
- application from the athlete (age category + 18 years, the receipt form is given in Appendix 2);
